



STEP 1: PLANNING

MATERIALS


- Class set of "Book Review" planning pages (2)
- Students' novels (to reference while completing the planning pages)
- Explain to students that they will be creating a Doodle Book Review for a book that they have finished reading.
- Distribute the "Book Review" Planning Pages.
- Quickly review the parts of the review in each box.
- Then, lead students through completing each part of the planning pages:
 - OVERVIEW: Students should note the title and author of the book. Then, have students shade in the star shapes to show a rating for the book. They should explain the rating that they gave the book below the stars.
 - QUOTE: Have students find a significant quote from the book. The quote can be dialogue or any other text from the novel. Have them write the text word-for-word on the lines.
 - 3 WORDS: Ask students to brainstorm three words that they could use to describe the book. You may want to provide students with thesauruses so that they avoid simple or common adjectives.
 - o **SUMMARY:** Lead students through each summary brainstorm question. Then, have students combine their answers to create a 2-3 sentence summary for the book.
 - SETTING: Have students skim through their books to find a description of a significant setting in the novel. Then, have students re-read the sentences about the setting before answering the questions on the planning page. Finally, have them sketch a picture of the setting based on the description from the book.
 - AWARD TIME: Explain to students that they will need to give their book an award.
 Have them think about what the book could be recognized for. For example: Edge-of-Your-Seat Award, Most Entertaining Book Award, Saddest Ending Award, Creative Characters Award
 - CHARACTER ANALYSIS: Have students write down a main character's name. Then, encourage them to list words or phrases to describe the character's appearance, personality, and actions.
 - PLOT: Have students write down a major plot event in the book and explain its importance.
- FYI: Directions for where students should add the information to the doodle page is at the bottom of each review box.




STEP 2: DOODLE REVIEW

MATERIALS

- Class set of "Book Review" Doodle page
- Students' completed planning pages
- Crayons, colored pencils, and/or markers
- After students have finished their planning pages, you might have them get with a partner to share what they have written.
- Then, pass out the "Book Review" Doodle page.
- Explain to students that they will be filling the doodle page with the ideas that they
 developed on the planning pages.
 - Overview Students should write the book title and author on the book shape. They can draw a picture on the cover if they would like. They should color in the stars to the right of the book shape to show the rating they gave the book.
 - o **Quote** Students should write the quote on the lines next to the owl shape.
 - o **3 Words** Students should write the descriptive words on the pencil shapes.
 - Setting Students should draw a picture of the setting in the setting shape. Have students add labels to their sketch.
 - Summary Students should write the summary on the lines under the word "Summary."
 - Award Students should write the name of the award that they are giving the book on the front of the trophy shape.
 - Character Students should fill the character shape with all the words and phrases that they listed while describing the character.
 - Plot Students should write the plot event on the lines under the words "important event."
- Give students an opportunity to color in their Doodle Book Review before sharing their book project with a partner or small group.
