8. Items for Discussion	<p>8.1 Spring Family BBQ & School BBQ Recap</p> <p><u>Family BBQ</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We had about 450 in attendance, who pre-ordered their meals. Treats were sold to make a profit for a Cheer Fund donation to a family in our school community. We rented games from A-1 rentals, along with face painting and obstacle course races. • For future Family BBQs, need to discuss possibility of a later date in June. As well as, sending the communication out via E-mail. <p><u>School BBQ</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The CSCC covered the cost of a school BBQ after year end Mass. All hot dogs, drinks and chips were prepped and ready to go for each class the day before. All the students ate their lunch on the front lawn. <p>8.2 Street Safety Update</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tasha spoke with the city today, the corner of Mapleford and Silverleaf will be converted to a 4-way stop. • The corner of Mapleford and Meskanaw has painted crosswalk lines. Bart has been directing parents to park over on Meskanaw since there is construction on Mapleford. However, they are about to start construction on that street again soon. Maybe the dirt lot will be safer for pickup/drop off once west construction is complete. • Tasha started the request for overhead Pedestrian cross lights/sign on Meskanaw. We can also contact SGI for grant as per CAA audit. Tasha to follow up in 3 weeks. <p>8.3 Backpack Night Recap</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Great feedback from Families that night and the Food trucks made the event way less stressful for the CSCC. We will continue to do this event as it makes the first day easier for students and parents. • Bart suggested in the future we set tables up in the court area at the back of the school. As well as posted on social media and EDSBY. <p>8.7 Fall Fundraisers</p> <p>Peak of the Market Veggies</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We didn't know if we were going to do this but there was a delivery date before thanksgiving. We like this one because families can donate to the food bank if you don't need it yourself. This fundraiser is open until September 24. With school pick up on October 5. Location in the school to be determined. <p>Winter Fundraiser</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>Benny's Christmas Dainty Tray</u>: these are nut free. There are no gluten free options.
